As you are well aware, the IRS uses what are called Transaction Codes (TC) numbers to record historical events in IMF/BMF transcripts. There are hundreds of TCs and to properly interpret master file records, you need to know what these codes are.

To help, IRS publishes Publication 6209, *IRS Processing Codes and Information*, a manual explaining all its computer system functions and abbreviations. Chapter 8 includes a description of every TC along with a detailed explanation for each.

Because of its importance, you need to have a copy handy at all times when reviewing IMF/BMF transcripts. A copy of the most recent edition of Pub 6209 is available using the above link.

Please take some time to quickly review chapter 8 but keep Pub 6209 at your side at all times when reviewing transcripts. This information is critical to your work.
